1.0 System Requirements

DVDneXtCOPY iTurns Minimum System Requirements

Win 2000, or XP PentiumIII® 500 MHz 10 GB of free hard drive space A DVD Writer and media

DVDneXtCOPY iTurns Recommended System Requirements

Win XP, Win X64, Win VISTA Pentium 4® 1.4GHz 15 GB of free hard drive space A DVD Dual Layer Writer and media

1.1 Helpful Tips

- Turn off all active programs including anti-virus before you begin.
- When using an external DVD burner, you should limit the number of additional external devices connected during the burning process.

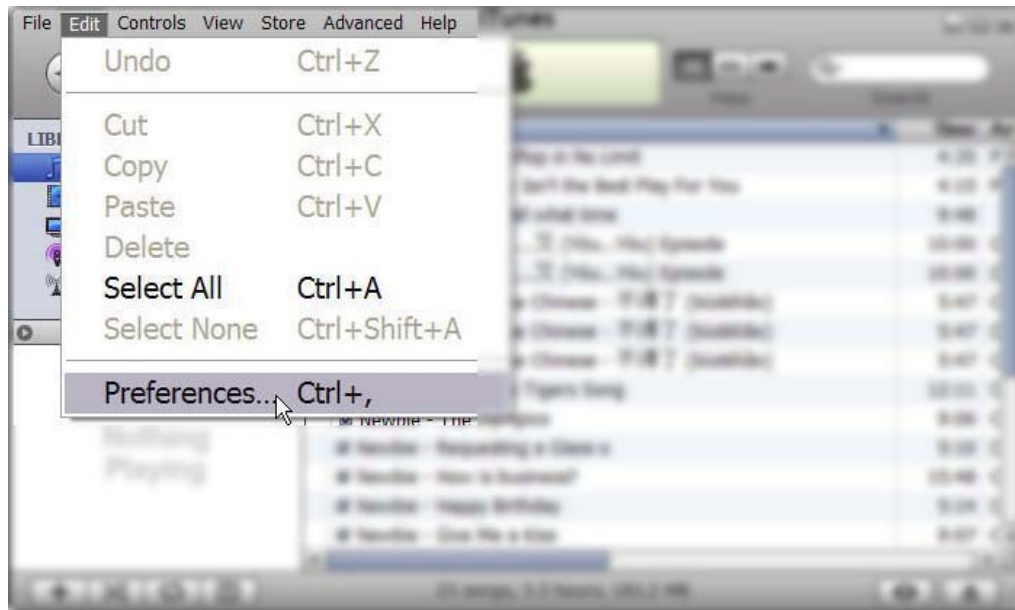

2.0 Configuring iTunes to run with DVDneXtCOPY iTurns

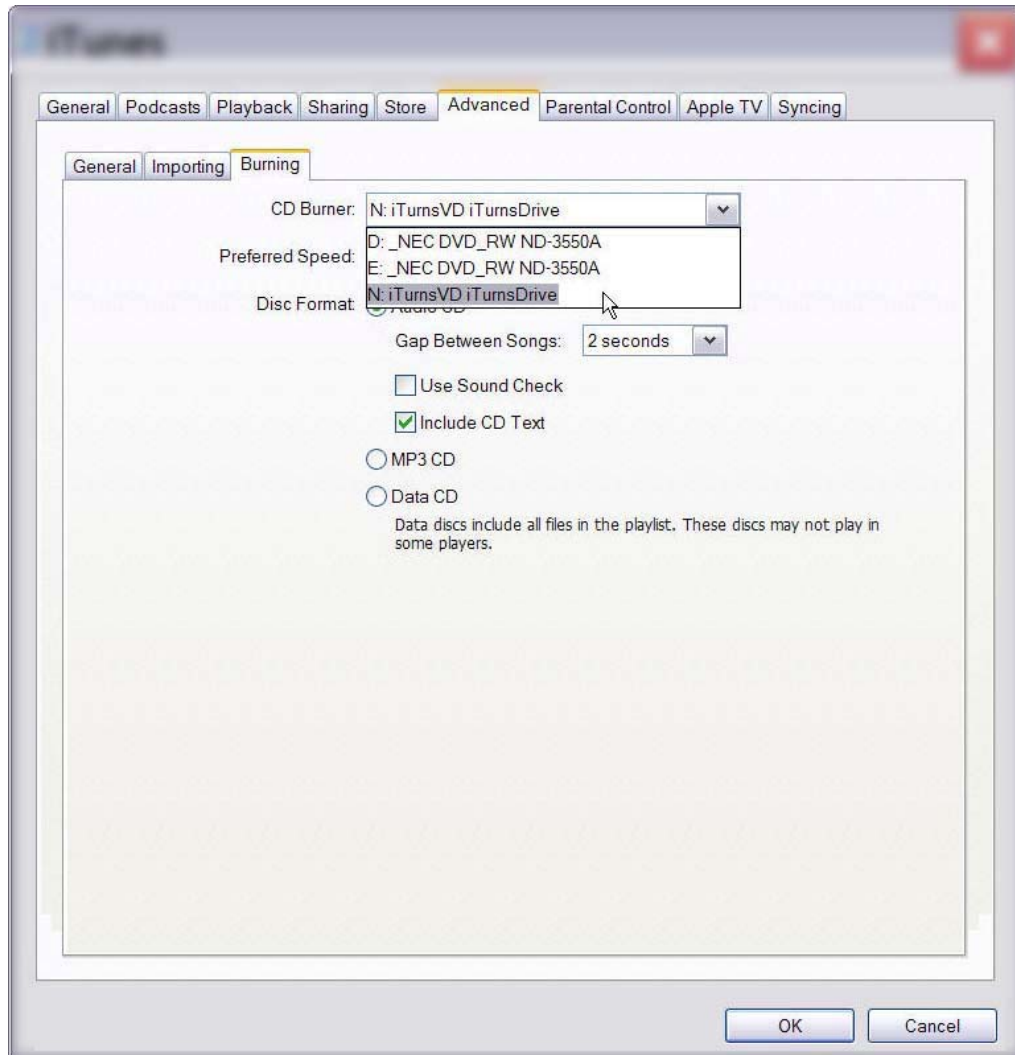
(Note: if you have iTunes version 8 or higher all you need to do is click the “Burn Disc” button on the bottom right corner of iTunes to bring up the burn settings and to choose iTurns as the CD burner device.)

You must first configure your iTunes software to run DVDneXtCOPY iTurns, so that you may convert the iTunes music from your iTunes library. You need to open iTunes and set DVDneXtCOPY iTurns as the default burning device. This setting is not permanent and can always be set back to the default position.

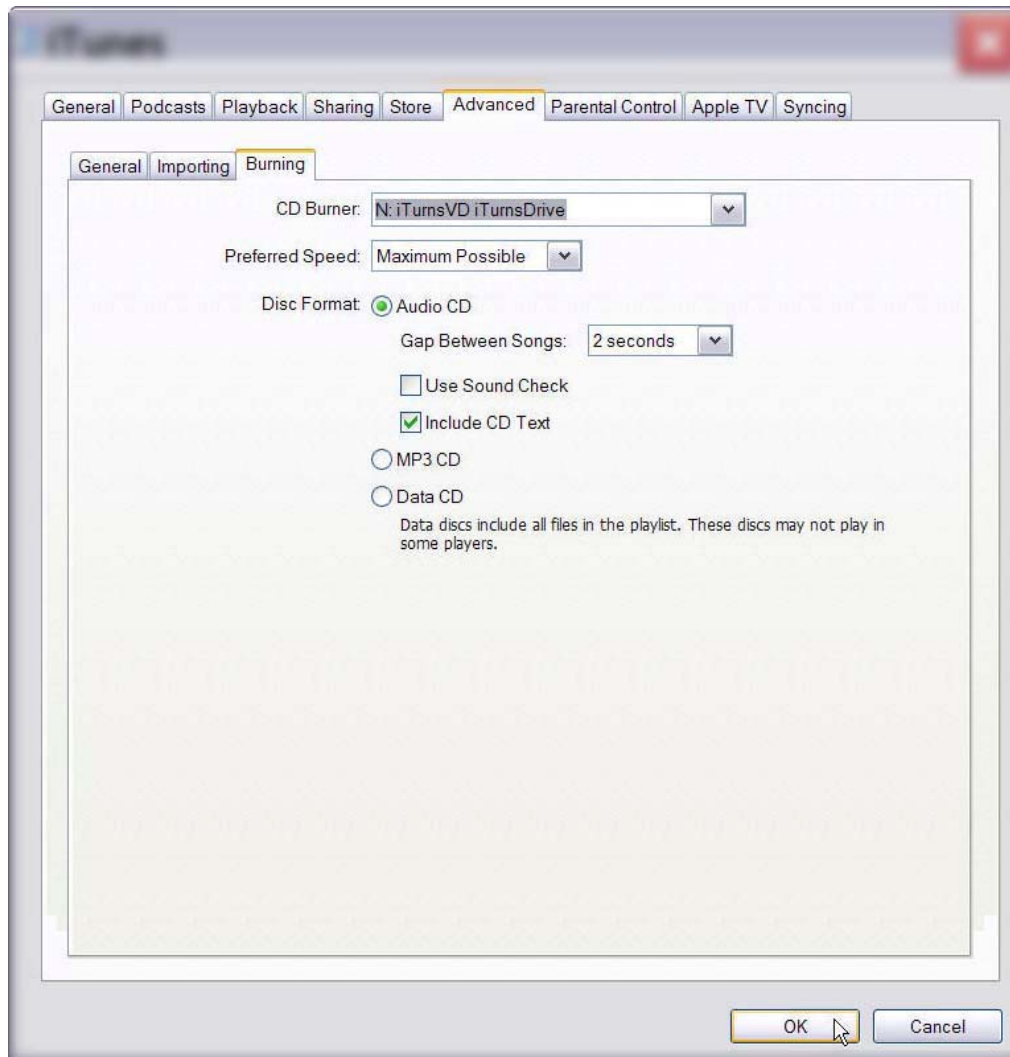
Step 1: Go to the main window of iTunes and click through the menu path “**Edit > Preferences > Advanced > Burning**”



Step 2: Select DVDneXtCOPY iTurns as the CD burner.



Step 3: Choose **Audio CD** as the Disc Format and check the **Include CD Text** check box. Click the **OK** button to save the changes. (This feature will only be used by DVDneXtCOPY iTunes PRO)



iTunes is now fully setup to work with DVDneXtCOPY iTunes. Now the next thing to do is configure your DVDneXtCOPY iTunes software.

3.0 Configuring DVDneXtCOPY iTunes

Start up your DVDneXtCOPY iTunes and once the program is running you will see a small yellow DVDneXtCOPY iTunes icon in the bottom right of your windows system tray. Right click on that and click on **Show Manager Window**.



By default, DVDneXtCOPY iTunes comes with a ready to use configuration. The default settings are.

- Projectpath : <Windows personal files folder>\DVDneXtCOPY iTunes
- This Folder is created while installation and is the folder where iTunes will create the new virtual burned projects.
- Audioformat (Encoder), The default settings are Mp3 / 192Kbit/s CBR
- Filenaming rule (Pattern), The default path is <artist>-<title>.mp3

You can change these settings to what you desire by clicking on the settings button from the DVDneXtCOPY iTunes Windows Manager.

4.0 Converting your iTunes Music so that you can use it on any device anywhere anytime you want.

Step 1: Start up your DVDneXtCOPY iTunes and once the program is running you will see a small yellow DVDneXtCOPY iTunes icon in your systems tray.

Step 2: Now Start your up your iTunes software.

Step 3: Choose any of your playlists or songs in your iTunes library and click on the **Burn Disc** button on the bottom right of your iTunes window.

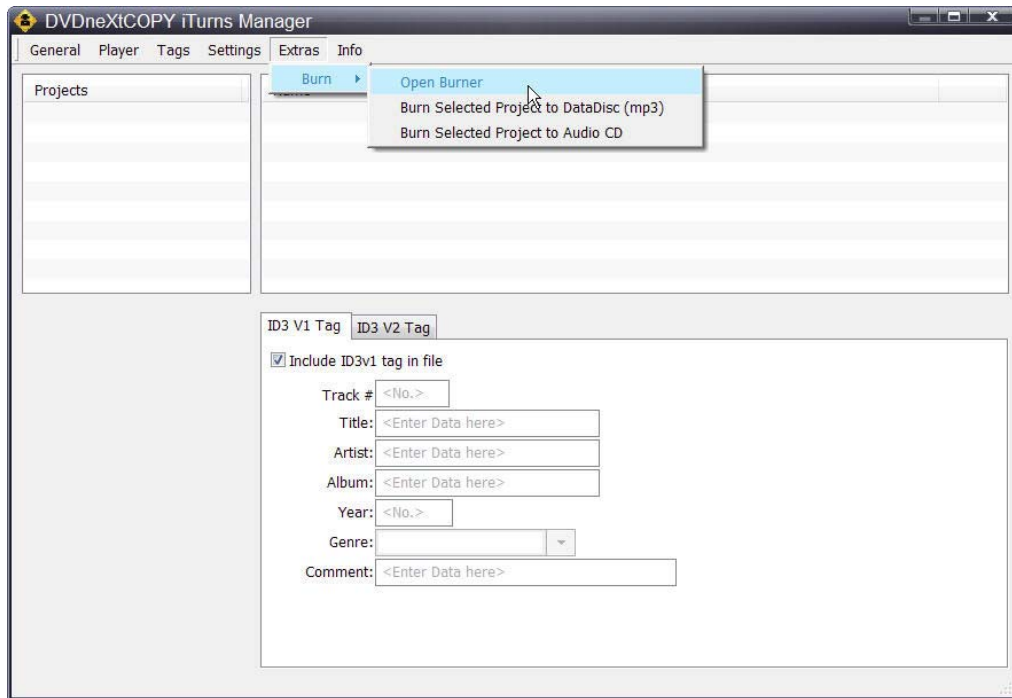
Step4: DVDneXtCOPY iTunes will now convert all of the songs you chose from your iTunes library into the the audio format that you selected within the DVDneXtCOPY iTunes settings. All of the converted music files will be stored on your computer in the folder you selected to store your converted music files.

5.0 Burning songs to CD with DVDneXtCOPY iTurns

Step 1: Once the program is running you will see a small yellow iTurns icon in the bottom right of your windows system tray. Right click on that and click on **Show Manager Window**.



Step 2: Click on **Extras > Burn >** and then choose if you want to burn an audio CD or a an MP3 CD.
